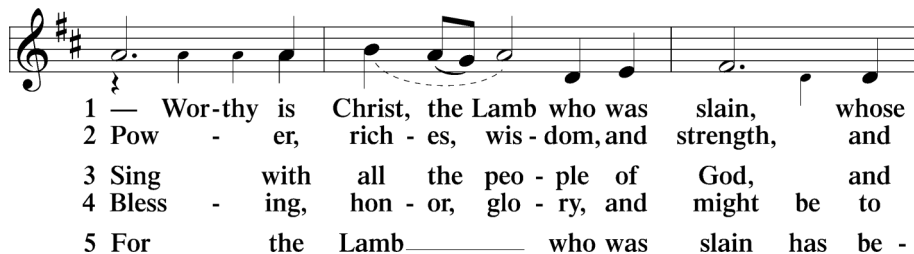

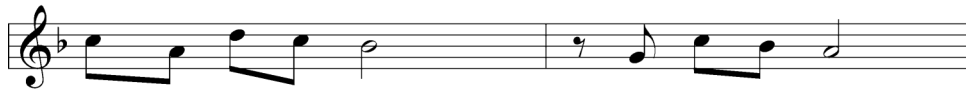

Hodos is a national gathering for young adults ages 18–29 who want to grow in their faith, connect with other believers, and be encouraged to follow Jesus in everyday life.

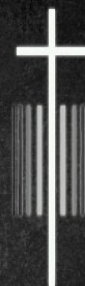
